

Trail Information

We have had our fair share of equipment issues this past month and are currently working on grooming with only two pieces of equipment, the LMC and John Deere. We need more snow!!!

The Tuscobia was groomed both ways on 2/10. More grooming is scheduled for 2/13, 2/14 and 2/15.

Trail 27/5 S is now open. Forestry worked with our crew to mark the reroute near the Bissel Grade. We have some major brushing to be completed before our groomer can go through the rerouted area. We have had volunteer riders out packing in the rerouted area so we can get the needed equipment in. Randy Neumann and Bruce Wick from Sno -Trails brought in their Ranger with drag to help with the first grooming of the year. Thanks guys!! Dale was out grooming again Feb 10.

Trail 5N has had considerable problems again this year with beaver dams making it so we could not get our groomer through. Musky Sno came in from the north on February 10 with their Ranger and small drag. They reported that they were able make it through the dam areas allowing us to be able to groom with our equipment. Thank you Tim Davidson and crew! Our groomer will be going out again on 2/12 or 2/13. We do have some brushing that will need to be done north of the beaver dam if you are looking for something to do.

Trail 6 is scheduled to be groomed again on 2/12. Terry has been doing an excellent job on this trail! The recent warm up did uncover a few rocks so we need more snow. Note: There is still a reroute from the Tuscobia to Polish Road.

Trail 9 has been recently groomed and reported as in good condition.

Trail 40 is scheduled to be groomed again on 2/12 or 2/13.


