#### **Membership Renewals**

As a reminder all AWSC memberships expired on June 30, 2020. If you have not renewed your Winter Huskies membership since June 30, 2020 you will **NOT** have an active AWSC membership to get your discounted trail pass.

\*\*\*Please allow time for your membership to be processed. It can take 2-3 weeks from the day you send your membership in before the update reaches AWSC.



### **Trail Information**

<u>Trail 6:</u> The section from G to Polish Road has been cleared from fallen trees and had been widened. This section will be open and ready to ride! Sections from Aborne Rd to Dam Rd have been widened to at least 16' wide. We are waiting for the swamps to freeze before we can finish widening the remainder of 6. The goal is to be able to fit the tractor with tracks on this trail.

Trail 5N (70 to Blaisdell): Hay bales have been stagged to drop into the swampy areas as they start to freeze. Our hopes is that this will provide us with a more stable area to pass through with groomers and sleds. A new gate was put in off Blaisdell per the landowners request. The club is working with the Sawyer County Alliance to contract a company to come in and brush this entire section once everything freezes and the landowners have given us permission. No work can be done in this area until after December 6th due to Muzzleloader season. We have had some club members out clearing areas that were accessible.

<u>Trail 5S (Tower Rd to Rusk County):</u> The Sawyer County Alliance has approved us to spend up to \$5,000 to contract a company to brush and widen parts of this section. We will have to wait until the wet areas freeze.

<u>Trail 9:</u> Has been mostly widened out. South end by Devil Lake Rd has some spots that will need to be filled in. North half has been brushed by Sno-Trails Snowmobile Club. We are again waiting for the rest to freeze so we can access

<u>Tuscobia:</u> The County hired a company to add gravel and improved sections over this past summer. It has just been graded from Price County to Birchwood. We need people out picking up large rocks and railroad spikes. Several "stop" and "stop ahead" signs are missing. A scheduled work day is set for November 14th.


