Trail Information

This month's report is short but sweet. As of January 14th, groomers have not been running much in the southern parts of the County due to there not being enough snow in some areas. However trails have been reported as in good shape. All we need is more snow for the groomers to run. Groomers have been running north of the flowage and have a deeper base.

We are anticipating a snow storm to come through over the next couple of days that can bring anywhere from 3 to 7" depending on the area. Fingers crossed that we are closer to the higher total.

The Alliance has worked with Winter Huskies to hire a contractor to complete brushing on 5N from 70 to Blaisdell and on 5S from Tower Rd to Rusk County. They have been running behind schedule but we will keep you updated on the progress.




