Your prayers have been answered! February 6-8 brought over 11" of much needed snow in the southern half of Sawyer County. Northern areas have reported higher amounts. Groomers have been working hard to get the trails in prime riding shape. On February 8, Rusk County was finally able to open trails allowing access points from all surrounding counties. More snow is expected the week of February 10.

The water issues on Trail 5 between Hwy 70 and Blaisdell Lake Road should now be resolved. If you encounter any issues on our trails please contact a club officer as soon as possible.

Use extreme caution when on Trail 6 from the Wannigan to the dam. Logging operations have begun and will likely continue throughout the season. The area has been posted.

A \$2.00 increase in AWSC membership (from \$10 to \$12) was proposed by the director's and voted in for next year.


Big Boyz Toyz Vintage Ride


